Boyds' Adjustable Combs for Rifles will provide a ½" of vertical travel adjustment.

To make adjustments, loosen the two locking rods by inserting a 5/32" hex wrench into the access holes in the top of the comb, insuring that they are indexed into the hex head bolt, and turn counter clockwise until loosened. (see figure 1 and figure 2)

Move the comb to the desired height and tighten the two locking rods by inserting a 5/32" hex wrench into the access holes in the top of the comb, insuring that they are indexed into the hex head bolt, and turn/tighten clockwise until locked. (see figure 3 and figure 4)
